

## **Traffic & Security Report 5/2022**

### **05/06/2022- Theft -5000 N. Braeswood Blvd.**

Deputies responded to a suspicious person call at this location. The caller observed a suspicious male in his neighbor's back yard. Deputies arrived to the location and found the male with several pieces of lawn equipment and a sword. The house in question was vacant at that time. The suspect was identified and released at that time because there was no complainant. On **05/14/2022**, deputies were called back to the residence in reference to the suspect mowing a lawn with a stolen lawn mower. The complainant originally did not want a police report made, but later changed his mind. The complainant's property was returned to him and a warrant was issued for the suspect's arrest.:

### **05/23/2022- In Progress Call- 9900 Balmforth Ln.**

Reportee called police about a male possibly pointing a gun at two males at the basketball courts. Deputies arrived on scene and did not find anyone with a gun. Deputies spoke to two males that were playing basketball at the time who told deputies that they did not see anyone with a gun.

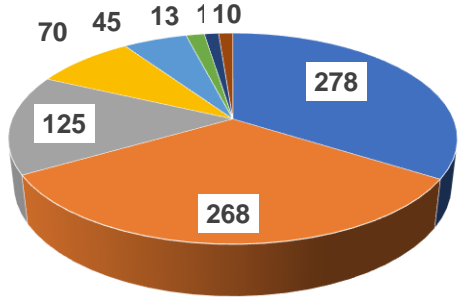
