DWI Arrest:

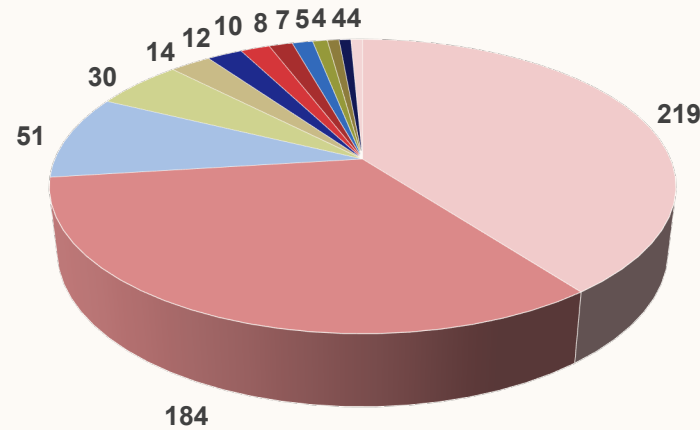

Some Key Takeaways for Meyerland Residents:

- If you have an alarm system, please arm it when leaving
- Install video doorbell systems or add video surveillance to your home
- Ensure that your alarm service has Pct 5 as the first to call in an emergency: **281-463-6666**
- Keep garage doors closed at night
- Keep valuables out of sight in your vehicles; park in the garage if you are able
- Consider a blocking container for your key fob for push button start vehicles to eliminate criminals from copying your code and stealing your car
- Consider Apple Air Tags or tracking devices; some vehicles with OnStar have been stolen and the service disabled
- Remind your contractors to close their windows and lock their vehicles, to prevent theft of wallets, cellphones and tools.
- Call the constable for suspicious people and/or cars in the neighborhood
